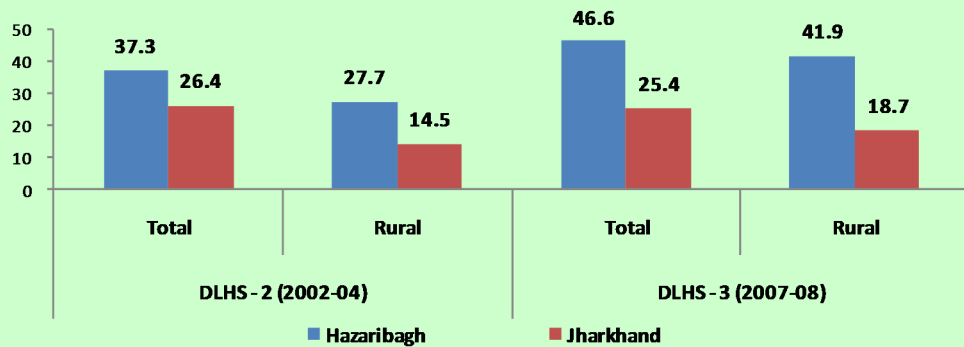
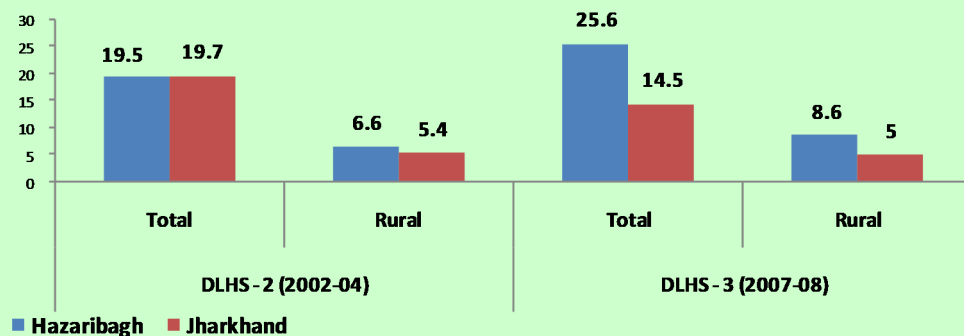

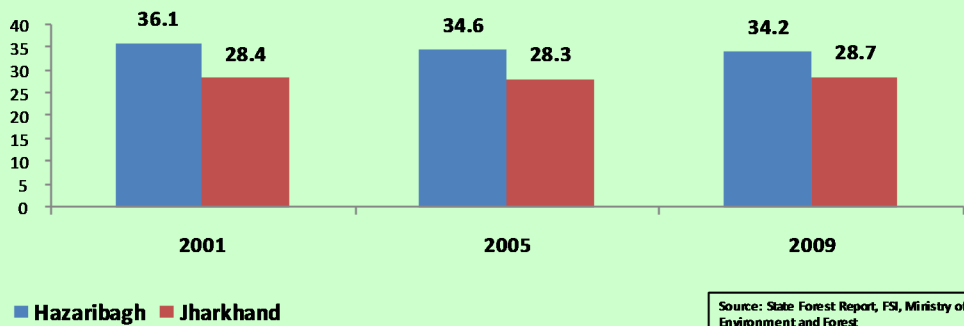

### Forest Coverage (%)



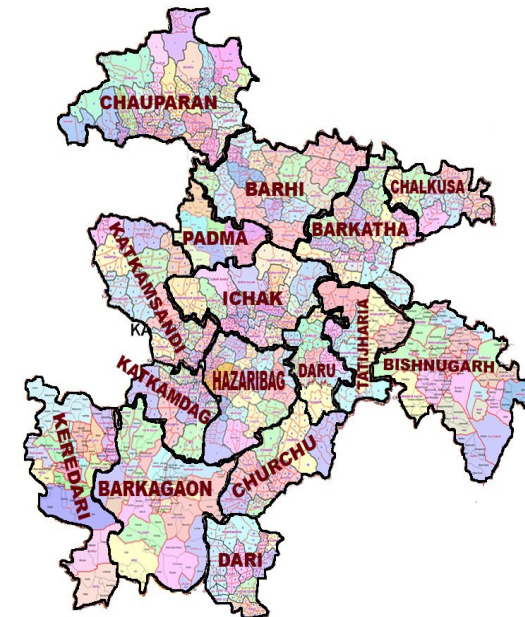

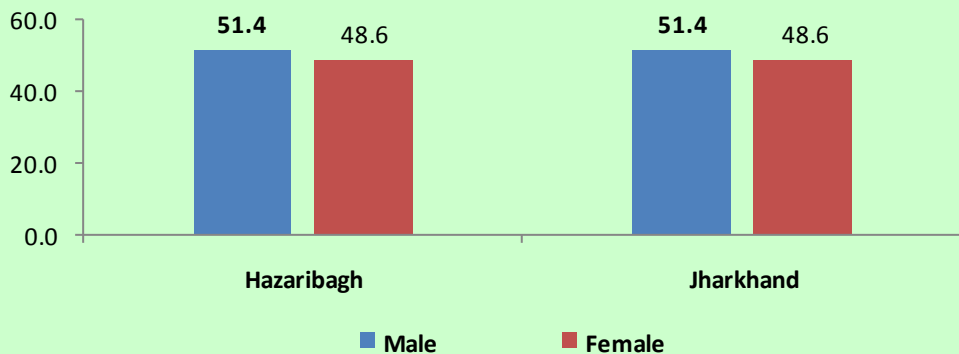

### Net Enrolment Ratio (primary level)

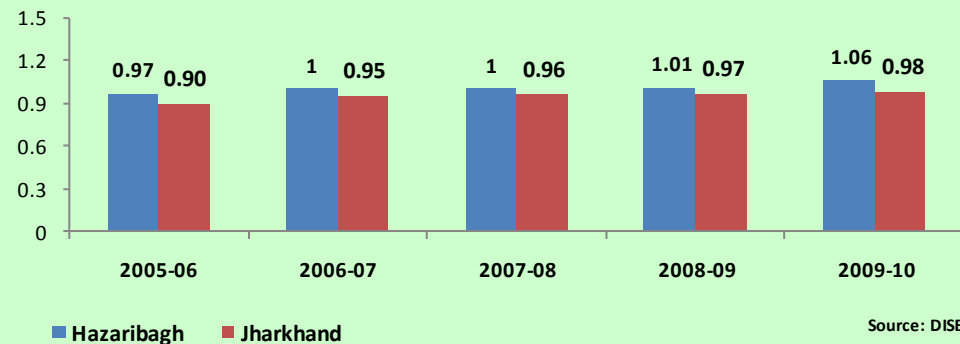

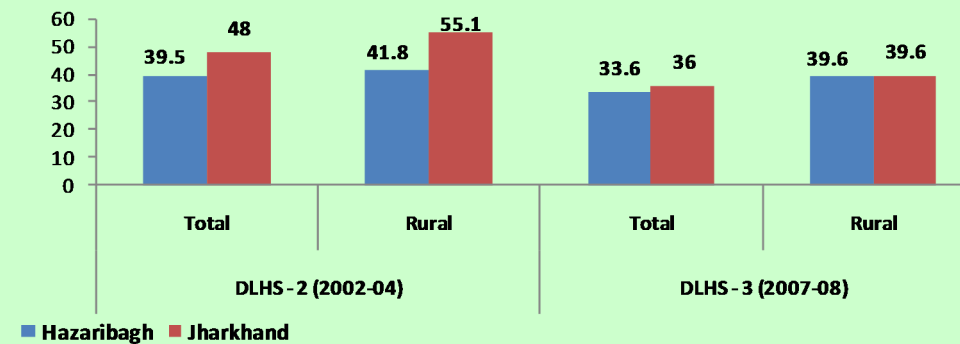

### Girl's marrying before completing 18 years (%)



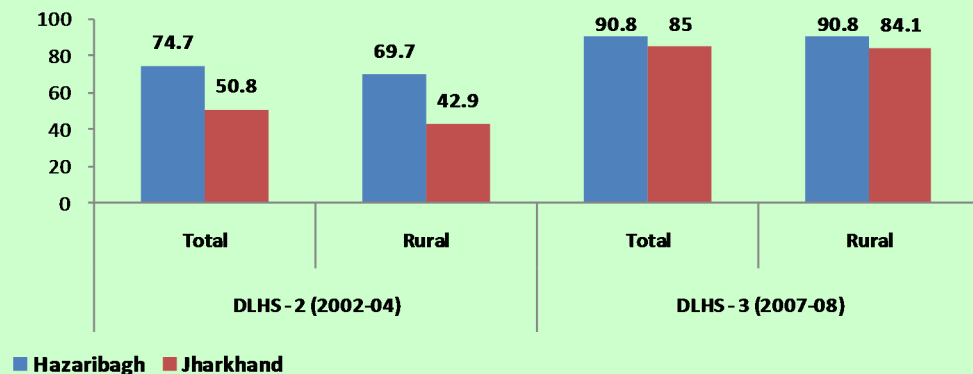

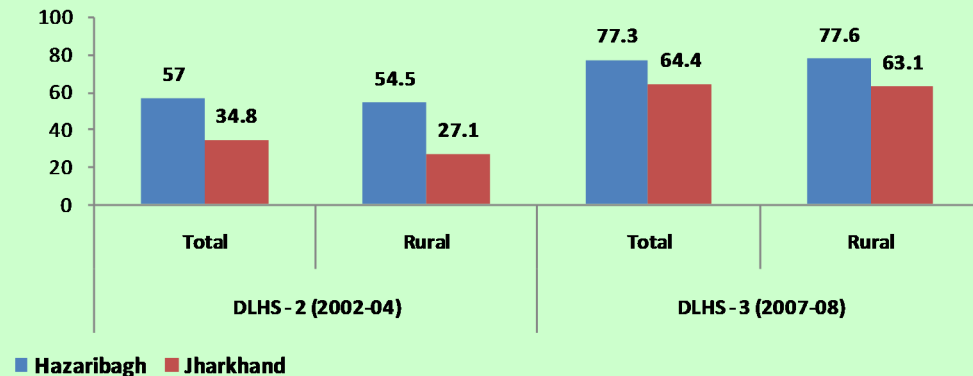
### Infant Mortality Rate (Total)



### Children (12-23 months) who have received BCG Vaccine (%)

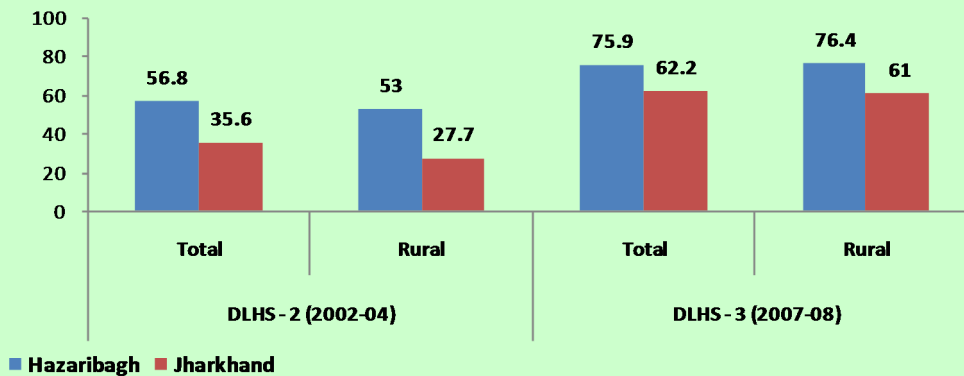


### Children (12-23 months) who have received 3 doses of Polio Vaccine (%)

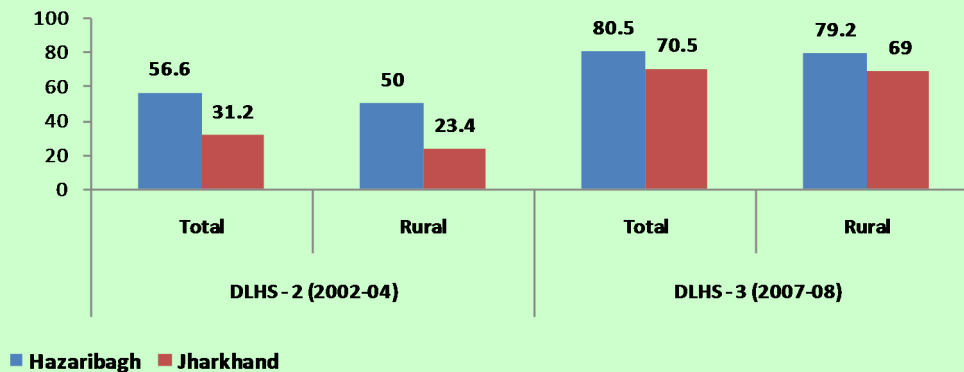

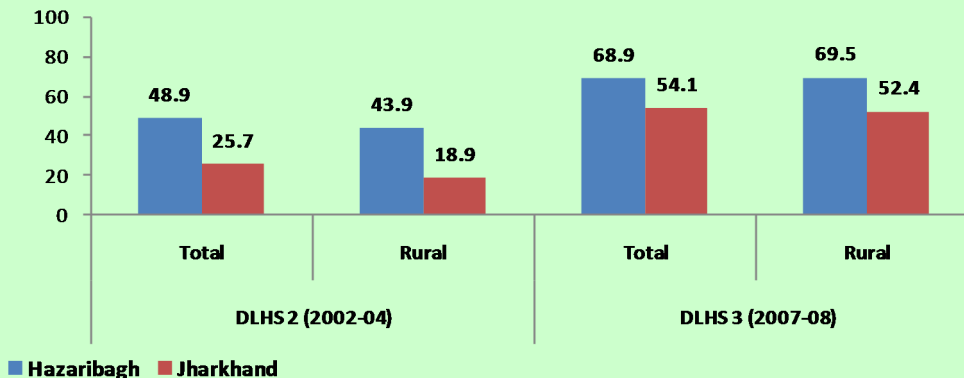
### Children (12-23 months) who have received 3 doses of DPT Vaccine (%)



### Children (12-23 months) who have received Measles Vaccine (%)



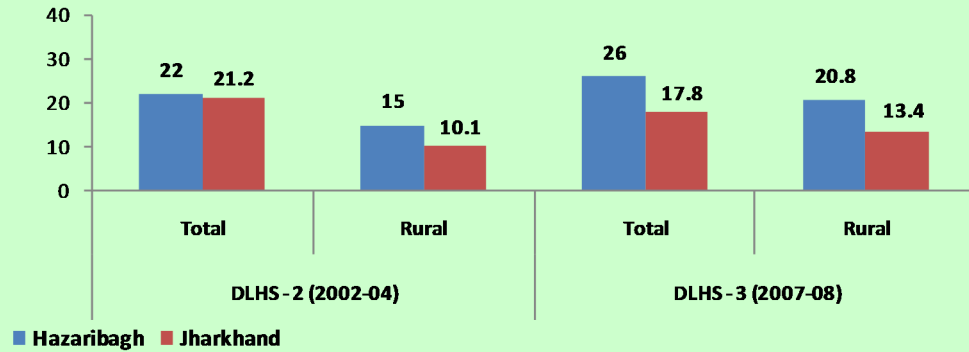
### Children (12-23 months) fully immunized (%)



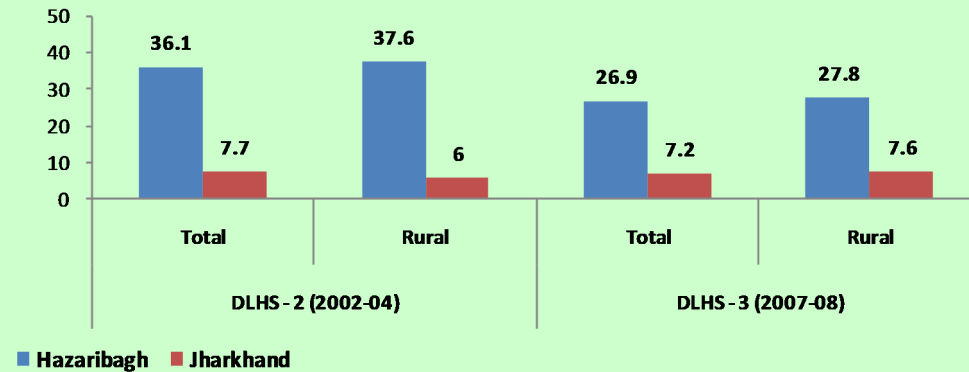

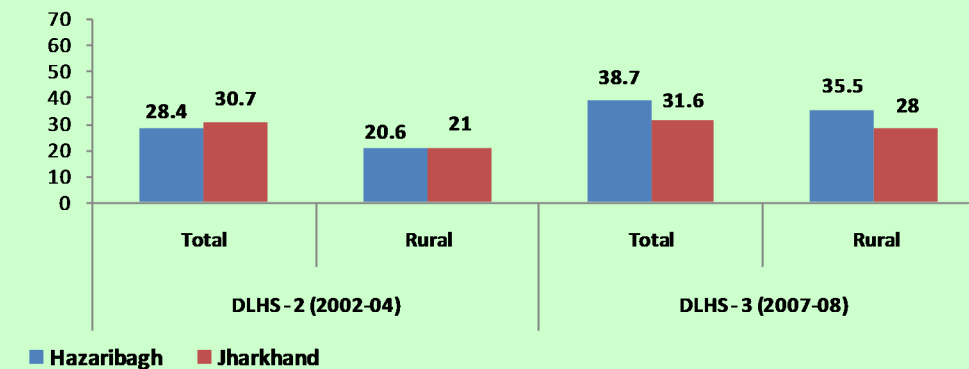
### Institutional Delivery (%)



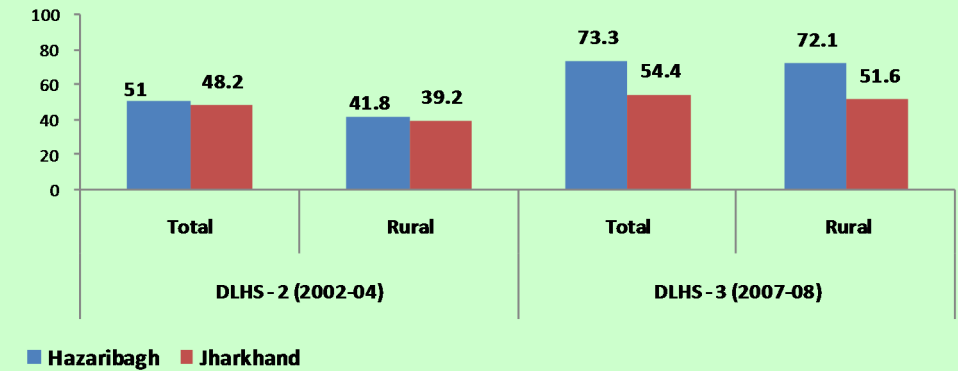
### Delivery at home & other places assisted by a doctor/nurse /LHV/ANM (%)



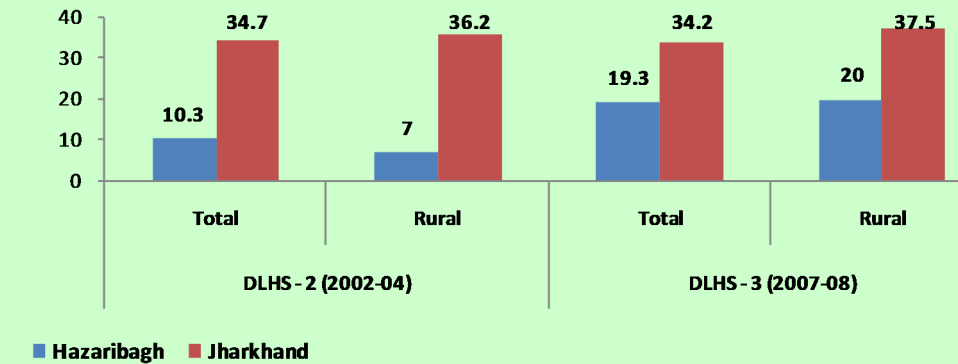
### Mothers having at least 3 Ante-Natal care visits during the last pregnancy (%)



## Mothers who got at least one TT injection when pregnant with last live / still birth (%)

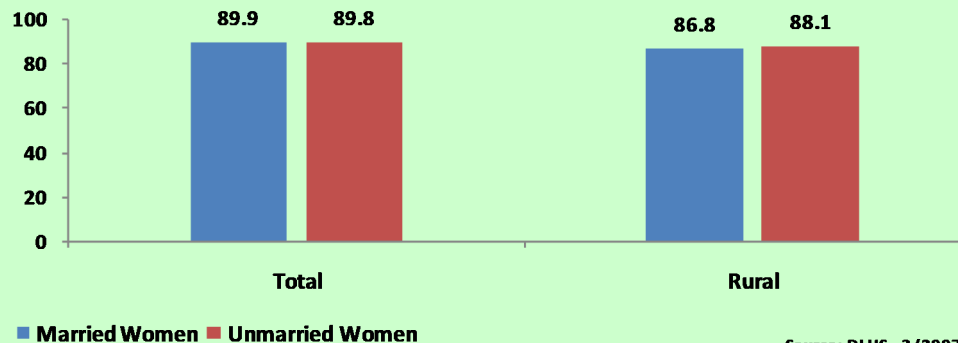


### Total Unmet Need (%)
